**State Visit of the President of Angola to India:** President On 3 May 2025, H.E. Mr. Joao Manuel Goncalves Lourenco, President of the Republic of Angola, was received by President of India, Smt. Droupadi Murmu at Rashtrapati Bhavan. Furthermore, President Lourenço and his delegation was also welcomed by the Indian Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi. It is worth nothing that after 38 years, the President of Angola is visiting India. In addition to providing India-Angola relations with fresh impetus and direction, this visit will fortify the alliance between India and Africa.

Key Outcomes of the State Visit of President of Angola to India include:

- **MoU and Agreements:** MoU between on cooperation in the field of Ayurveda and other Traditional Systems of Medicine; MoU on Cooperation in the Field of Agriculture; and Cooperation Programme in the Domain of Culture for the period 2025-29.
- **International Frameworks:** Angola signed the International Solar Alliance (ISA) Framework Agreement and became the 123rd member of the ISA.
- **Defence Cooperation:** India approved a \$200 million defence credit line for the modernization of Angola's armed forces.
- **Technology and Development:** India will share capabilities with Angola in Digital Public Infrastructure, Space Technology, and Capacity Building.
- **Sectoral Ties:** India aims to deepen collaboration in healthcare, diamond processing, fertilizers, and critical minerals.
- **Cultural Ties:** A Youth Exchange Programme for building people-to-people relations.
- **Counterterrorism:** Both nations reaffirmed their commitment to combating terrorism, with Angola expressing solidarity over the recent attack in Pahalgam, India...
