Background

Modern warehousing absorption is projected to approach 45 million square feet, with Grade-A stock expanding rapidly at a CAGR of 13.85%. Simultaneously, driven by strict compliance needs in pharmaceuticals and an expanding food-processing sector, the domestic cold chain market is scaling aggressively, projected to reach INR 6,191 billion by 2034.

While this structural growth is evident, the industry must still navigate key challenges including market fragmentation, high operational and energy costs, and the critical need for seamless multimodal connectivity. The integration of Industry 4.0 paradigms—ranging from Automated Storage and Retrieval Systems (AS/RS) to real-time IoT temperature visibility—is essential to overcome these bottlenecks and redefine international benchmarking for Indian supply chains.
