

State visit of the President of India to the Slovak Republic: President Droupadi Murmu arrived in the Slovak Republic on April 9, marking the first Indian presidential visit to Slovakia in 29 years. Welcomed warmly by Slovak President H.E. Mr. Peter Pellegrini at the Presidential Palace, both leaders held extensive strengthening bilateral on ties addressing global issues. President Murmu invited Slovakia to collaborate in India's growing media and creative industries and participate in the WAVE Summit in Mumbai. Two MoUs were signed on MSME cooperation and diplomatic training....

Sri Lankan President Anura Kumara Dissanayake conferred upon him the Sri Lanka Mitra Vibhushana—the nation's highest honour for foreign leaders—making him the first Indian recipient. The leaders held in-depth talks on connectivity, development, defence, economy, and reconciliation. Emphasising Sri Lanka's significance in India's Neighbourhood First Policy and Vision MAHASAGAR, seven MoUs were exchanged...

8th Session of India-Russia Working Group on Priority Investment Projects held in New Delhi: The 8th Session of the India-Russia Working Group on Priority Investment Projects (IRWG-PIP) convened in New Delhi on April 9, 2025, under the Intergovernmental Commission framework. Both nations signed a protocol identifying key strategic projects and agreed to incorporate six new initiatives aimed at enhancing bilateral investment. The meeting reviewed progress since the 7th session and reaffirmed a commitment to deepen economic cooperation across sectors of mutual interest. Discussions emphasized collaboration in infrastructure development, transport engineering, digital economy, and energy. Both sides highlighted the importance of facilitating investments through favorable fiscal regimes and joint ventures, particularly in the Russian Far East and India's industrial corridors. The session underscored the shared goal of achieving a bilateral trade volume exceeding USD 100 billion by 2030, reflecting a strategic partnership poised for significant growth...
