79th U.N. General Assembly, 2024: On 23rd September 2024, Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi addressed and participated in the 'Summit of the Future' at the United Nations in New York. This Summit aimed to reaffirm commitments to the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) and the **Nations** Charter while enhancing cooperation and laying the foundations for a reinvigorated multilateral system. The Summit concluded with the adoption of an outcome document - A Pact for the Future, along with two annexes, Global Digital Compact and A Declaration on Future Generations...

At the summit, Quad Leaders announced new initiatives to solidify these habits of cooperation and to set up the Quad to endure for the long-term...



The Leaders commended the progress that has made the U.S.-India Maior Defense Partnership a pillar of global security and peace, highlighting the benefits of increased operational coordination, information-sharing, and defense industrial innovation. The Leaders recommitted to expand the manufacturing and deployment of clean energy, including finding opportunities to expand U.S.-India cooperation in solar, wind and nuclear energy and the development of small modular reactor technologies...









Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi meeting with the Prime Minister of Australia: Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi and Prime Minister of Australia H.E. Mr. Anthony Albanese met on the sidelines of the 6th Quad Leaders' Summit in Wilmington, USA. This was their ninth in-person interaction since May 2022. The two leaders discussed strengthening bilateral cooperation across a wide range of areas such as political and strategic, defence and security, trade and investments, education and research, climate change and renewable energy, and people-to-people ties...

Official Visit of His Highness Sheikh Khalid bin Mohamed bin Zayed Al Nahyan, the Crown Prince of Abu Dhabi to India: His Highness Sheikh Khaled bin Mohamed bin Zayed Al Nahyan, Crown Prince of Abu Dhabi is on an official visit to India from 9-10 September 2024. The Crown Prince held bilateral discussions with Prime Minister of India. They acknowledged that the success of the Comprehensive Economic Partnership Agreement (CEPA) and the recent entry into force of the Bilateral Investment Treaty (BIT) will provide further impetus to the strong economic and commercial partnership between the two countries. Several MoUs/Agreements were signed during the visit, which set the stage for enhancing cooperation in traditional as well as new areas of cooperation...







Official visit of Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi to Singapore: Shri Narendra Modi, Prime Minister of India, paid an Official Visit to Singapore on 04-05 September 2024. Both Prime Ministers welcomed the second meeting of India Singapore Ministerial Roundtable (ISMR) held last month in Singapore. India and Singapore strengthened their ties with the exchange of four significant Memorandums of Understanding (MoUs) during Prime Minister Narendra Modi's visit to the island nation. The MoUs cover collaboration in digital technologies, the semiconductor sector, health and medicine, and education and skills development...

Shri Piyush Goyal inaugurated Invest India's Singapore Office: Union Minister of Commerce & Industry, Shri Piyush Goyal inaugurated Invest India's new office in Singapore. The Singapore Office is Invest India's first overseas office. This significant move reinforces India's commitment to deepening investment partnerships and making it easier for global investors to engage with India. The Singapore office will serve as a dedicated point of contact for companies from the region looking to invest in India, fostering collaboration across sectors...

India climbs one position to 39th rank in Global Innovation Index 2024: India is now among the top 40 countries in the Global Innovation Index (GII) for the first time, moving up one place to the 39th rank out of 133 economies in the world. This was confirmed in a report released by the Geneva-based World Intellectual Property Organization. With this, India continues to remain at the top among the 10 economies in Central and Southern Asia and also 1st among lower-middle-income economies. Notably, India was at 40th place in last year's Global Innovation Index rankings...

India signs first-of-its-kind agreements focused on Clean Economy, Fair Economy, and the IPEF Overarching arrangement under Indo-Pacific Economic Framework for prosperity: The Agreement on Clean Economy intends to promote technical cooperation, workforce development, capacity building, and research collaborations; and collaborate to facilitate development, access, and deployment of clean energy and climate-friendly technologies with the aim to collectively accelerate efforts of IPEF partners towards energy security and transition, climate resilience and adaptation and GHG emissions mitigation. IPEF Fair Economy Agreement aims to create a more transparent and predictable trade and investment environment across the Indo-Pacific. To achieve these goals, the IPEF partners will collaborate to enhance their efforts in preventing and combating corruption, including bribery, and supporting initiatives to improve tax transparency, the exchange of information, domestic resource mobilization, and tax administration...

During the day, Minister had a number of bilateral meetings and other engagements alongside the 12th EAS EMM. The day started with a bilateral meeting with H.E. Dr. Kan Zaw, Minister of Investment and Foreign Economic Relations, Myanmar wherein both sides discussed potential cooperation areas in trade and the ongoing AITIGA review negotiations...





Commerce and Industry Minister Shri Piyush Goyal co-chairs 21st ASEAN-India Economic Ministers meeting in Lao PDR: Shri Piyush Goyal, Commerce and Industry Minister during the 1st day of his visit to Vientiane, Lao PDR (20th September, 2024) co-chaired the 21st ASEAN-India Economic Ministers (AEM-India) meeting alongwith H.E. Malaithong Kommasith, Minister of Industry and Commerce of Lao PDR. The Ministers reviewed the trade and investment relations between India and ASEAN and reaffirmed their commitment to further strengthen the relations. India and ASEAN registered a bilateral trade of USD 120.9 billion in 2023-24 with ASEAN accounting for 10.9% of India's global trade...

Shri Piyush Goyal also inaugurated ECGC's new online service portal, alongside a revamped inhouse SMILE-ERP system. These innovations mark a significant leap towards paperless processing and faceless service delivery, benefiting both exporters and banks...

APEDA facilitates first consignment of Indian Pomegranates from Mumbai to Melbourne: The Agricultural and Processed Food Products Export Development Authority (APEDA) facilitated the first consignment of Indian pomegranates from Mumbai to Melbourne, Australia, on August 31, 2024. This successful export not only underscores India's capabilities in meeting global quality standards but also provides a significant boost to Indian farmers by opening up new revenue streams. The consignment was successfully cleared in Melbourne and was showcased at Fine Food Australia 2024 at the APEDA India pavilion, further highlighting the global appeal of Indian pomegranates...





APEDA to promote alcoholic beverage exports as a part of 'Make in India' initiative: The global demand for Indian spirits is increasing, presenting an opportunity for growth. The Agricultural and Processed Food Export Development Authority (APEDA) plans to promote both the Indian alcoholic and non-alcoholic beverages globally with a target of USD 1 billion in export revenue over the next few years. APEDA as part of the 'Make in India' initiative has been targeting to increase exports of Indian Spirits to major foreign destinations. India currently ranks 40th in the world for alcoholic beverage exports...

DGFT updates the SCOMET List with recent policy changes and updates in the multilateral export control regimes: Directorate General of Foreign Trade (DGFT), Ministry of Commerce & Industry, has notified the updated SCOMET list for the year 2024. India's export control list (SCOMET) has been updated, incorporating the recent changes /updates in the control lists of the multilateral export control regimes, and certain policy amendments in our national system, on the basis of inputs from relevant government organizations and stakeholders. With the recent update, DGFT has also authorized the Department of Defence Production (DDP), MoD, to be the licensing authority for export of all items falling under Category 6 of SCOMET for military end use, streamlining certain exclusions existing earlier....
