Centre selects Jharkhand to scale up mustard output

Bengaluru-Tumkur Namma Metro project likely to have 19 elevated stations

Kerala

Kerala govt grants INR760 crore to KSEB to recover losses

The Kerala State Electricity Board (KSEB) has been granted INR760 crore by the state government. The state government issued directives in December 2023 requesting that 75 per cent of the loss sustained by the KSEB during the 2022-23 fiscal be assumed.

JSW Energy arm inks pact to acquire Reliance Power's wind project

JSW Renewable Energy has signed a business transfer agreement with Reliance Power to acquire a 45 MW wind project in Maharashtra for INR 132 crore.

The central or state transmission network would be connected to the energy storage network (ESS), which can be technology agnostic.

Punjab

Punjab govt to purchase 736,011 MT of wheat from farmers in Amritsar

Approximately 940,000 metric tonnes (MT) of wheat is expected to be produced in Punjab's Amritsar. Of this, the state government will purchase 736,011 MT at INR 2,275 per quintal. A total 11 sub-yards and 38 markets have been set up in the district for the purchase of wheat.
